

GENERAL ASSISTANCE NOTICE

The municipality of Corinna administers a General Assistance Program for the support of the poor.

Pursuant to Title 22 MRSA §4305, the Municipal Officers have adopted an ordinance establishing that program. A copy of this ordinance is available for inspection at the Corinna Town Office. Also available for inspection, is a copy of the State's General Assistance Statutes, as the Maine Department of Human Services makes copies of the State law available to the municipality.

The municipality's General Assistance Administrator must issue a written decision regarding eligibility to all applicants within twenty-four (24) hours of receiving an application.
