OPERATOR'S REPORT:

Operator's reports for the months of January and February were reviewed and discussed.

BUSINESS ITEMS:

-Dan emailed to say that the daily water flow at the plant on February 15 and 16 was unusually high. It was traced to a water leak at a mobile home at the Winchester Avenue mobile home park. The park maintenance person was notified and it was repaired.

-Dan reported that Olvers received a **Notice of Noncompliance** letter from the Maine Drinking Water Program claiming that CWD did not meet the Radium testing requirements for 2022. Since the report was submitted (although late due to our failure to send payment on time) Dan feels that we did in fact meet the requirements and he is attempting to get this violation rescinded.

REVIEW OF ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

15 accounts are paid in full for the 4th quarter.
17 accounts still owe.

Jim commented that we need to watch this closely, as it is unusual for so many accounts to be unpaid two months after the bills were sent.
