Selectmen's Meeting Minutes @ The Levi Stewart Library's Jones Nutter Auditorium July 22, 2020 – 6 P.M.

Item 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER - FLAG SALUTE. Chairman Whitney opened the meeting at 5:59 PM followed by the pledge.

Item 2. PUBLIC COMMENTS. None.

Item 3. NEW BUSINESS.

A. Fernald Ave. Reconstruction Bid. Bids were opened and amounts were as follows: Clark's LLC bid \$86,512.50; Lawson's Landscape Construction bid \$89,900. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Chairman Whitney 2nd to award the bid to Clark's LLC in the amount of \$86,512.50. All in favor.

B. Paving. There was some discussion about whether or not to put paving out to bid or just contract with a paving company. There was also discussion about which roads to pave. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Selectman Bolstridge 2nd to put paving out to bid, for the following roads:

Amsden Road – approximately 0.86 miles

Bond Road - approximately 1.33 miles

Bowden Road – Approximately 2.03 miles

Corinna Center Road – Approximately 3.66

Elliot Street – Approximately 0.14 miles

Greenbush Road – Approximately 1.13 miles paved; plus a 2" binder and surface on a portion of the gravel road

Ireland Avenue – Approximately 0.27 miles

Line Road – Approximately 0.86 miles

Maple Street – Approximately 0.37 miles

Pleasant Vale Road – Approximately 1.58 miles

Smith Road – Approximately 1 mile

Fernald Avenue – This road is being reconstructed and will need to be fine-graded prior to paving with 2" binder and 1.25" of surface. It would work best if this road can be paved as soon as contractors complete reconstruction. This road has a reconstruction completion date of October 12, 2020.

Four in favor. Selectman Littlefield opposed.

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Item 4. ADJOURN MEETING. Selectman Bolstridge made a motion and Selectman Emerson 2nd to adjourn the meeting. All in favor.
