Selectmen's Meeting Minutes @ The Levi Stewart Library's Jones Nutter Auditorium Wednesday, August 23, 2023 – 6 P.M.

Item 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER - FLAG SALUTE. Selectman Carr called the meeting to order at 6:00PM, followed by the pledge.

A. Board Members present: Jim Emerson, Alden Bolstridge, Dennis Carr, Tony Bennett. Absent - Chairman Roger Whitney.

B. Employees Present: Lois Jones, Justin Gudroe.

C. Residents Present: Jackie Emerson.

Item 2. AGENDA ADJUSTMENTS. None.

Item 3. APPROVE MINUTES.

A. July 26, 2023. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Selectman Bolstridge 2nd to approve the minutes, as written. All in favor.

Item 4. WARRANT AND PAYROLL DISCUSSIONS AND SIGNING.

A. Payroll Warrant #32 & 34. Selectman Bolstridge made a motion and Selectman Emerson 2nd to approve warrants #32 & 34. All in favor.

B. A/P Warrant#33 & 35. Selectman Bolstridge made a motion and Selectman Emerson 2nd to approve warrant #33 & 35. All in favor.

Item 5. PUBLIC COMMENTS.

A. Jackie Emerson – Voiced a concern about the individuals residing in the bandstand.

Item 6. NEW BUSINESS.

A. Pole Permit x2. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Selectman Bolstridge 2nd to approve both pole permits. All in favor.

B. Appointment – Roger Belanger, and David Watson for Planning Board; Mary Nye for Cemetery Committee. Selectman Bolstridge made a motion and Selectman Emerson 2nd to approve the appointments, as written. All in favor.

C. V-plow for public works. Selectman Bolstridge made a motion and Selectman Emerson 2nd to approve the purchase of the V-plow from Allied Equipment, for \$6,942, from the Public Works reserves. All in favor.

D. B. Howes, wants to sell cemetery lot back to Town – Morse's Corner West. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Selectman Bennett 2nd to purchase the cemetery lot in Morse's Corner West, back from Ms. Howes, for \$100. All in favor.

E. Patron Policy for Stewart Free Library Building. Manager presented information regarding a loitering/camping/overnight sleeping, parking policy. Portions were duplicated from Caribou and Lewiston. The building portion was written by the librarian. Manager will combine all areas needing some sort of regulation to arrive at one policy for presentation at next meeting.

F. Farmer's Table Liquor License. Discussion included no complaints or concerns with the liquor license. Selectman Emerson made a motion and Selectman Bolstridge 2nd to approve the Farmer's Table liquor license. All in favor.

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Item 7. OLD BUSINESS.

- A. Department of Labor inspection report.** Manager provided information regarding the results of the DOL visit. Public Works was missing some training documentation and needs an eyewash station – Total fines are \$1,400. The Fire Department was missing some training documents and some hose testing is not complete – total fines are \$4,200. Manager has scheduled an informal conference to provide some fire department training documentation to reduce the fines. Manager has also requested a penalty discussion – this will occur after all citations have been remediated.
