

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT TOWN OF CORINNA
STATE OF MAINE – COUNTY OF PENOBSCOT

TO: Brandon Bemis, a resident of the Town of Corinna, County of Penobscot, and State of Maine.

GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of Corinna qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Stewart Library Building's Jones Nutter Auditorium in said Town on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 at six o'clock in the evening (6:00 p.m.) to act on the following Articles:

ARTICLE 1

To elect a moderator to preside over said meeting.

ARTICLE 2

Shall the Town authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept the donation of land on Main Street, Map 18, Lot 146, previously sold to Familie Haus Weigle Trust.

ARTICLE 3

To see what action the town will take concerning the location of a new fire station, previously voted to be placed on Map 18, Lots 143, 144, 145.

(Recommendation to utilize Map 18, Lots 143, 144, 145, 146, & 147.)

ARTICLE 4

To see if the Town will vote to allow the funds from the sale of the Fire station/annex lot, Map 18 Lot 74, to be deposited into the Corinna Fire Truck Reserve.

Selectmen recommend a favorable action.

The Registrar of Voters will be available at the place of voting, one hour before the Special Town Meeting starts on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, for the purpose of registering new voters and correcting the voting list.
